Key Artist

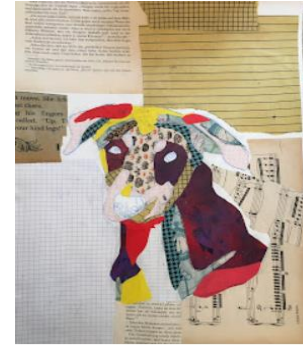
Michel Keck's art career began in 2003. Born in Dakota in the U.S.A.
