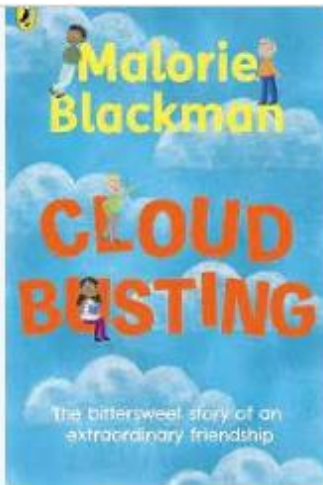

# Reading Recommendations



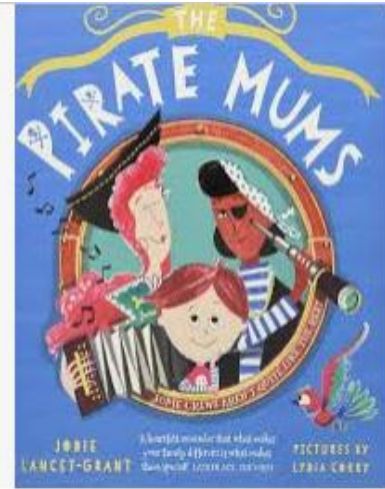
## Cloud Busting

Cloud Busting is one of my favourite texts that we read with children on The Literacy Pirates programmes.

Malorie Blackman has been writing books that speak so clearly and persuasively to the experience of young readers for decades, and this one is no exception.

The early reveal that the narrator is a bully floors the group every time! The ensuing tale of friendship and bravery brings so much to discuss, with the added bonus that the whole book is in verse and uses a different style each chapter. We love it as an inroad into poetry and author intentions.
