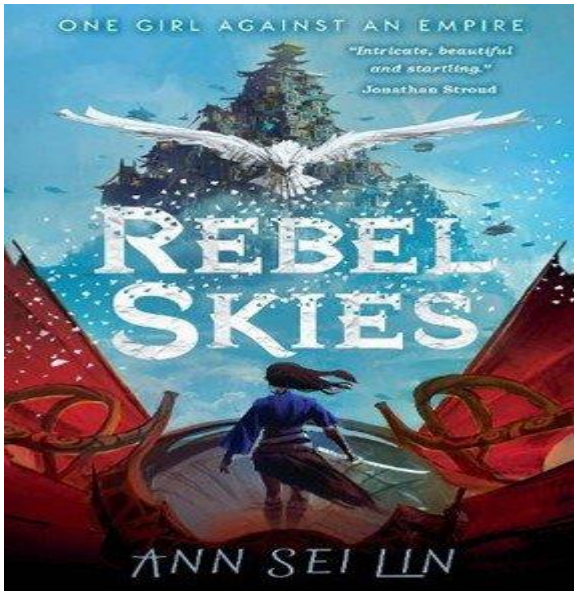
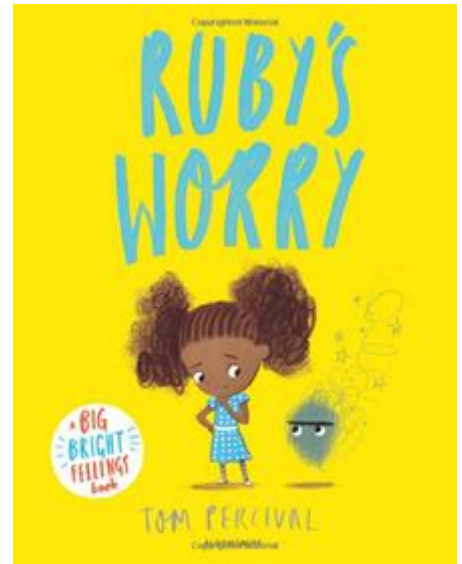

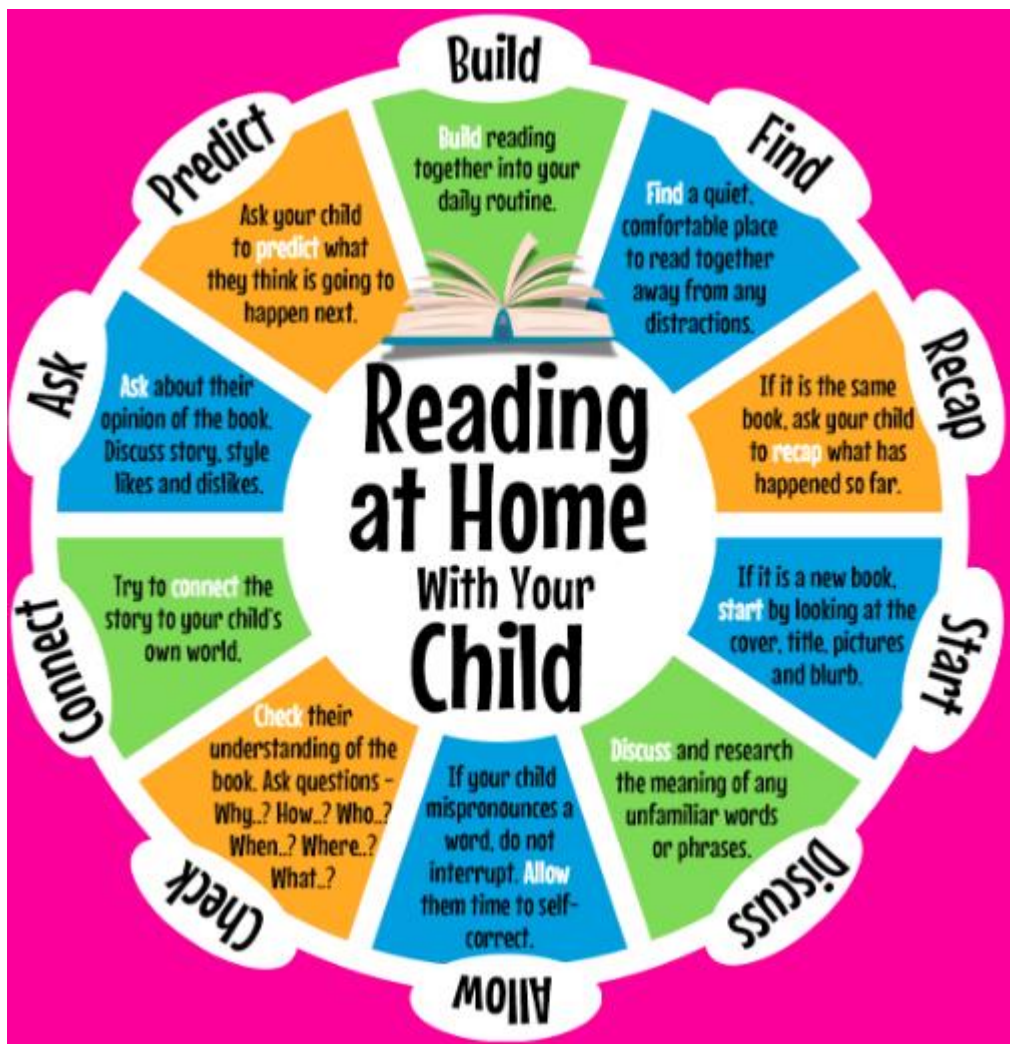
Ruby's Worry - by **Tom Percival**
